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NAVIGATING NONRESIDENT ALIEN TAXATION

U.S. Taxation of foreign visitors to the U.S. can be very complex. Did you know?

- An separate set of laws applies to taxation of nonimmigrant visitors, who may have to file designated Nonresident forms with the IRS.
- The U.S. has tax treaties with over 50 other nations conferring certain benefits to some nonimmigrant visitors to the U.S.
- Failing to file U.S. taxes can adversely impact immigrants and visitors on future immigration applications.
- A visitor can be on a nonimmigrant visa and be considered a resident alien for tax purposes even if he or she is not a permanent resident. (The rules for determining residency are entirely separate than those used for immigration purposes and are easily confused).
- There are special, complex tests used to determine if a foreign national is a nonresident alien or a resident alien for tax purposes.
- Once a visitor meets the Substantial Presence Test, he or she is taxed on worldwide income.
